

## Pointe de sur Cou

Pointe de sur Cou as its name says, overlooks a place name that is a magnificent pleonasm. This top that is part of the first ridge of Bornes Range is detached from the rest of the range by a pass called Col de sur Cou.

However, Cou already means pass.

This top is facing Roche Parnal and Montagne de Sous Dine. It overlooks on one side the basin in which is the Alp of Balme, and on the other side the Plateau des Bornes.

The Salève is then just on the other side.
