

## Rochers de Leschaux

Rochers de Leschaux is a karstic formation that is the continuity of Plateau des Glières and Parmelan. There are, however separated from them by the valley of the Borne. Thus, the limestone plateau that is making the top of Rochers de Leschaux displays an impressive break overlooking the valley of Borne.

It is among one of the typical top of the Bornes Range and since it is located in front of the range, the view is especially remarkable.

The difficulty of the hike is essentially due to some tricky steps that one has to cross in order to reach the plateau.
