

Tour Saint-Martin (or Quille du Diable)

The name of Diablerets comes from the ancestral superstition that the top of this mountain was the habitat of the imps. It was said that, from time to time, the devils played with pucks and that, when they missed the pins, the puck fell on the side of Derborence. The frequent landslides were explained in this way.

No wonder why the monolith on the edge of the precipice is called Devil's keel.

We will not climb the summit, but we will go to the foot of this tower, now made accessible by the melting glaciers.
